Our clients are rough sleepers, and people at risk of homelessness; people recovering from substance abuse; adults and children escaping domestic violence and abuse; refugees striving to build a new life in a safer place.

They are prison leavers seeking to re-integrate into society; Autistic adults in need of specialist supported housing; and members of the Gypsy, Roma, Traveller and Boater communities who are living insecurely.

A client's progress may not always be linear, but our teams don't give up. We meet each person where they are and help them to navigate their next steps – whatever they might be, however many times they need to retrace them.

£100


could provide a basic move-on kit including kitchen utensils, bedcovers etc. for someone who is ready to move on to independent living.

By adding a voluntary £1 donation to customers' bills, it's a simple and for your business and customers to raise money and help support our cause.

How it works:

Step one: sign up at julianhouse.org.uk/dineanddonate. You will then receive our welcome pack containing posters, tent cards, press release template and social media hints and tips.

Step two: set up a button on your electronic till and brief your colleagues or ask us to come and talk to your colleagues.

Step three: let your customers know you are taking part! Tag @JulianHouseUK on your socials.

Step four: collect the total raised at the end of the agreed period, and send it to Julian House.





Making the most of fundraising



Matched giving: Ask your employer to match the cash you raise through your fundraising activities.

Gift Aid it: for every one pound you donate, HMRC will give us an extra 25p, at no cost to you.

Promotion: put up posters across your office, utilise your internal comms and send out emails to promote your fundraising across the organisation.

Get in touch with us: We are on hand if you need any advice, help with resources or branding.
